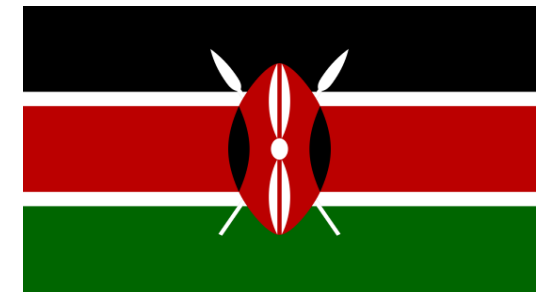


Africa & Kenya

Key Facts

Kilimanjaro is the highest mountain in Africa.

The **Nile** is the longest river in Africa.

The **Kalahari** and the **Sahara** are deserts in Africa.

Kenya is near the **equator**.

The climate in Kenya is **tropical**; it can be extremely hot and can have heavy rainfall.

Many people in Kenya live in homes made of **thatch** and **dried mud**.

Many people visit Kenya for a safari holiday, on safari they see many different animals including: lions, cheetahs, elephants, zebras, hippos and wildebeest.

Continent	A very large landmass of the world which may include many countries. There are 7 continents in the world.
Safari	A trip to observe animals in their natural habitat.
Swahili	A language spoken in Kenya.
Jambo	Means hello in Swahili.
Climate	Climate is the average weather (temperature, cloudiness, rainfall) in a place over many years.
